PGC Spring Meeting Brings Strategic Assessment

The Protective Glazing Council's Spring Meeting, scheduled April 11-12th at the Hyatt Regency Orlando International Airport Hotel in Orlando, Florida, is a departure from the recent Symposium format. Rather than holding a two-day educational event for the local architectural community, the Board of Directors has chosen to assess PGC's progress in the industry over the past several years. They will establish a set of objectives that enhance the Association's promotion of technological solutions to the increasing issues facing the world's structures.

As such, the event begins on April 11th with a brief meeting of the Board of Directors, followed by the Strategic Assessment session administered by Mr. Jim Daniel. Daniel, President and CEO of the Hexagon Group, has two masters degrees, a doctorate, and completed post graduate study at Harvard University.

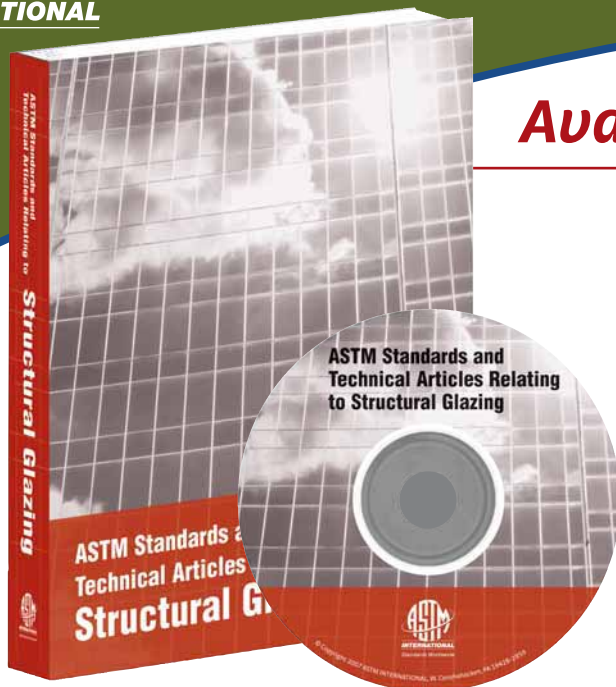
